## Action Items

- Random Hit Prizes
  - For the Fall 2025 and Spring 2026 season we would like to generate a random number once the seasons are completed and go back through DartConnect to find all instances where players hit that score. Every time a player hit that score, they would be entered into a random drawing that can be drawn over facebook live or youtube or at the end of year banquet. The captains were asked if they felt a set of darts valued about \$90-115 would be a good prize. All in attendance seemed to like the idea. This has also been discussed on the Facebook page. Lucien LeVeille found two sets that would fit the criteria. Target Redoux 01 in 23 gram option and Harrows Black Knight in 22g. These are a straight or "pencil style" barrel in the most common weights currently used.
- End of Year Random Hit Prize
  - Similar to the seasonal hit prize, a random number will be generated and we will look through the entire 2025-2026 season for every instance where the selected score was hit. For every time a person hit that score, they will receive one entry into the drawing. Captains were asked their opinion on doing a complete portable board setup as a prize. This would include a dartboard (either Blade 6 or Target Tor) a portable dartboard stand, and a surround. This was also discussed on Facebook and received a lot of positive feedback. The approximate cost as of March 5th 2026 is \$208.75 on [Amazon.com](https://www.amazon.com)
- The cost of league shirts is down this year because we decided to go with a new service. We will be trying sublimation transfers that Lucien will press onto the shirts at no extra cost to the league. This does free up some money in order to do things like the above Random Hit Prizes.
- League Debit Card?
  - We would like to look into a debit card for the league to make purchasing for the league more streamlined. As an example, to pay the DartConnect invoice, we have to get and print the invoice, send it to Zuri to get a check or cash. She then gives the money or check to Dan or Lucien. They then deposit the money and process the transaction using their personal card. The paid invoice is then printed and submitted back to Zuri. This is just one example where a debit card would make it a lot easier to get things done efficiently.
  - Zuri has looked into this for us and will get the ball rolling on this as soon as possible.

- A former player asked Lucien about the tablet holders at the Bowling Center. Lucien spoke with Dan Croteau about this and he agreed that we should take them down.
  - Dan Croteau went to the Bowling Center on April 6th and took them down. Those tablet holders are at Dan's house.
- Lucien was asked by one of the captains what they were supposed to do with the tablet holders at the VFW come the end of the night. Previously they had been told to leave them and the bar staff would put them away but they were recently told by someone in the NCDL that they need to be putting them away at the end of the night.
  - Dan Croteau said that we can leave the tablet holders as of now. If we choose to close them up in the boards, we are welcome to do so but since the holders normally go in another cabinet, the bar staff will put them away.
- We have been approached by some of the staff at the local bars about players approaching them and complaining to them about the cost of drinks or food.
  - Neither the Dart League nor the waitstaff set the prices. Please be courteous to the waitstaff and the establishments. Without them we would not have a dart league.
- Section 7F of the bylaws states "Upon completion of the final 501 set, there will be 10 minutes allocated for a team break." Please keep this as close to 10 minutes as possible. During week 13, it was observed that the boards were empty for over 30 minutes. One team was inside, warming up while most of the other team was outside still. Please be courteous to other teams as well as the bar staff.
- The 2026 Spring Fling Ding-a-ling Bingo is sold out!
  - If any teams do not have their baskets in, please reach out to Shaunna Croteau ASAP to make arrangements to get them turned in.
  - This year Sam St. Onge (Scentsy) and Fagin's Pub have also donated baskets.
  - We will be providing a donation to the Northwoods Cancer Survivor's group to benefit families affected by cancer.

- The end of the year banquet will be on May 16th 2026. It will be held at the VFW. Food and prizes will start about 3:00pm and we would like to get a LOD started by 5:00pm.
  - We will have partial catering provided by the Dumpling House
  - If anyone is able to bring desserts or chips, that would be greatly appreciated as well!
- Dan Croteau brought up a situation that he had heard about but didn't have complete information about. In one of the matches a player asked the scorekeeper what they had thrown. The scorekeeper accidentally gave the wrong total which was realized after the player's next dart was thrown. The scorekeeper did apologize and admit they made a mistake once it was realized
  - In a situation like that, the player can rethrow any darts that were thrown after a mistake like this from the scorekeeper. If you ask what is thrown and the scorekeeper tells you the wrong amount after your first dart then you throw your next two darts thinking you were at a particular score, you are able to pull the last two (after both the thrower and scorekeeper acknowledge the mistake) and rethrow both darts.
  - In addition, once a player hits their required out or last mark in cricket, the game is done. If a player has 16 left and hits a Double 8 on their first dart, the game is done. If they choose to throw their remaining two darts, this is not a bust because the game is complete already.
